

### Minutes

December 1, 2016 Hilton Miami Airport Hotel

**Second Vice President Jordan W. Leonard,** Mayor, Town of Bay Harbor Islands, called the meeting to order at 7:10 p.m., he introduced **Andreana Jackson**, Commissioner, North Bay Village, to give the invocation.

Mayor Roberto Martell, Town of Medley, lead us in the Pledge of Allegiance.

Vice President **Leonard** asked for a motion to approve the minutes and the consent agenda. The motion passed by unanimous vote.

Vice President **Leonard** then asked MDCLC Executive Director **Richard Kuper**, to present the Tenth Annual Turkey Drive awards.

Executive Director **Richard Kuper** spoke of how hard the MDCLC works to assist our municipalities and those families in need in Miami-Dade County. He also discussed what a success the Turkey Drive was and thanked all who assisted. He asked that everyone turn to the end of the agenda to look at the Turkey Drive highlights. Mr. Kuper went on to thank this year's Tenth Annual Turkey Drive sponsors and volunteers. This year MDCLC distributed over 1000 turkeys and bags of non-perishable foods thanks to the City of Hialeah Gardens, Wal-Mart, City of Miami Beach, TruckMax, Baptist Health South Florida, and Wells Fargo we were able to give less fortunate families a Thanksgiving meal. Mr. Kuper then presented awards to; Mr. **Gil Chez**, Sales Manager, TruckMax for donating two refrigerated trucks and drivers for the distribution of the turkeys and cans. City of Miami Beach Manager **Jimmy Morales**, **Esq.**, for providing police escorts for the Turkey Drive so that the commute from municipality to municipality for the distribution can be made during the course of one day.

The City of Hialeah Gardens, Mayor **Yioset De La Cruz**, and his staff member, Mr. **Manuel Carrera** for providing staff and assuring that Wal-Mart has all of the turkey's for the drive ready. Mayor De La Cruz has been committed to helping the League with this drive for the past 7-8 years. Mr. Kuper then presented Mayor De La Cruz with an award for his service, City Attorney of Hialeah Gardens Mr. Charles Citrin, Esq. accepted the award on his behalf. He then awarded **Maria Luisa Gonzalez Silva** of Baptist Health South Florida for providing us with a van and a driver to transport the MDCLC Staff along with supplies for the event.

Mr. **Kuper** then spoke about the MDCLC scholarship awards. This year the MDCLC will be presenting five students with scholarship awards. Three of the five students were able to attend the December Board of Directors meeting. The three present Miami-Dade College students were presented with the MDCLC Scholarship award. The students must have a GPA of 3.0 or higher and will intern in three municipalities. The objective of the scholarship program with Miami-Dade College is to provide the students with local government experience. Mr. Kuper then introduced the three scholarship recipients, **Diana Aguilar**, **Eugenia Bolivar**, **Dana Pedraza**. Each student expressed their gratitude and appreciation and thanked the League for the opportunity given to them. The other two students will be present with their scholarship at a later date.

Vice President Leonard then introduced Miami-Dade County Public Schools Board member Susie Castillo for the educational minute. Ms. Castillo mentioned that on November 22, 2016 the Miami-Dade County School Board welcomed two of its newest elected members. Ms. Maria Teresa Rojas who will be representing District 6 and Dr. Steve Gallon, III who will be representing District 1. The School Board also elected its Chair and Vice Chair for the 2016-2017 term, Dr. Larry Feldman and Dr. Marta Perez Wurtz. Ms. Castillo then mentioned that the School Operations Attendance Boundary Committee held its final hearing for the targeted schools for the 2016- 2017 school year. Targeting schools is the first step in the lengthy process of changing school attendance boundaries. Several factors are considered before initiating a boundary change. Including use of available student stations, promotion and maintenance of diverse school enrollment, and degree and extent of transportation available to the students. Regions will hold Community Meetings from January 17, 2017 to February 6, 2017 where boundary recommendations will be presented to members of the affected communities and where they will be given an opportunity to share their input with District staff. Ms. Castillo then asked that the League distribute the ABC Calendar to all Board Members so that they can attend and help develop the changes by participating in the community meetings.

Vice President Leonard thanked Board member Castillo for the update.







# Miami-Dade County League of Cities Tenth Annual Toy Drive Highlights
